## Important Dates

Contest entry forms should be received by committee no later than Sept. 15, 2009.

Entries are to be delivered to Kent State Field House no later than 12 (noon) on Wednesday, October 7, 2009.

Contest display and voting is Saturday, October 10, 2009 at Tailgate Alley at Dix Stadium. Winners announced during the Homecoming Game.

Non-winning entry pick up times: Saturday evening after Homecoming 2009 - 5:00 - 7:00 pm Sunday, Oct. 11 - 1:00 pm - 3:00 pm Monday, Oct. 12 - 5:00 - 7:00 pm

All non-winning entries remaining after pick-up dates will become the property of Kent State University.

All winning entrants agree that entries may be used at Kent State University's discretion for current or future promotions, including, but not limited to: exhibition and display of actual entries during the centennial year (Oct. 2009-June 2010), photographic images of entries on Web sites, television, printed mail pieces and any other publications or promotional items the university deems appropriate.

- 1. Only Kent State Centennial Squirrels purchased from the Kent State Centennial Squirrel Committee are eligible to be entered. The contest is open to all Kent State students, student organizations, staff, faculty, alumni, all community residents, merchants and organizations.
- 2. All squirrels must have the words: Kent State University Centennial 1910-2010 visible on some upper surface. The 8-inch squirrel will have these words printed on the log base. The 30-inch squirrel will need to have these words added by the entrant.
- 3. Squirrels may be painted, sculpted, transformed, embellished, clothed, adorned, collaged, etc. Mediums and materials used are artist's choice, but the structural integrity of the squirrel must remain intact. All attached objects must be firmly affixed so they are not readily removed.
- 4. All designs must be appropriate for public display. The committee reserves the right to deem any squirrel inappropriate for the contest.
- 5. Entrants are responsible for any transportation that is required for their squirrel/s.
- 6. Entrants may submit more than one design, but each should be on a separate registration form.
- 7. The committee reserves the right to disqualify any entry which does not conform to contest rules. The committee reserves the right to eliminate any category which does not have a minimum 8 entrants and to combine categories where necessary to reach the minimum entrant levels.
- 8. Prizes will be awarded in each size and category. Number of prizes awarded will be determined on donations received and number of entries in each size and category.
- 9. There will be one winner in each category that will be selected by popular ballot. Winners will be announced at the Homecoming Festivities on October 10, 2009 to be held at Dix Stadium.
